GENERAL

- Tips for all areas in the home -
- Turn all overhead lights and lamps ON
- Replace all burned out bulbs and use bulbs of the same temperature – I recommend soft white instead of daylight for a warmer, cozier vibe
- · Turn all ceiling fans, TV's and computer screens OFF
- · Open blinds and curtains to let in natural light
- Remove personal photographs and replace them with landscape or object art
- Remove small floor rugs to reveal actual flooring

EXTERIOR

- Creating great curb appeal and a back yard oasis -
- Close garage doors
- · Remove cars from driveway and front of home
- Clean up landscaping (mow, trim, clear leaves, spread fresh rock or mulch)
- Power wash and paint areas with chipped paint
- Remove empty planters
- · Remove visible water hoses, kids toys and sports equipment
- Use fresh outdoor pillows & cushions
- Add pops of color with pots of fresh flowers by the front door

INTERIOR - Defining Your Space -



- Clear countertops except for a few decorative items
- Hide small appliances like toasters, crock pots, and air fryers
- Take magnets, papers, and photos off the refrigerator
- Hide garbage cans in the pantry, closet, or under the sink
- Feature one center piece in each room such as a bouquet of fresh flowers, a bowl of fresh fruit, or a decorative object
- Hide booster chairs and high chairs
- Remove any visible pet bowls and pet beds
- Display fresh pillows and blankets
- Declutter fireplace mantel

BEDROOMS

- Display fresh bedding that is not stained or faded
- Use pillow cases and shams that match the bedding
- · Clear night stands, dressers and desks of personal items
- Remove family photos, decals, names and posters from walls

BATHROOMS

- Remove floor mats
- Clear countertops of soaps, toothbrushes, and medications leave only decorative items like candles or fresh flowers
